#### Criteria of "International"


- Studying according to the international ECTS-System (Bachelor/Master)



Aim: to train specialists who are able to effectively contribute to the mitigation of and adaptation to the drastic effects of Global Change




#### The big '+' of Eberswalde

- Large number of international co-operation programs














































# Master Students (GCM)

# Experiences/Conclusions



In spite of the supposed attractiveness (innovative programs, good studying conditions, good career opportunities) the number of (international) master students is only partly satisfying
